


FUTURE READY SPECIALIST NEWS- from Liz Spencer

NEWS FROM THE SCHOOL COUNSELOR-

Do you have a baby who was born in July or August? Would you like to volunteer with your baby to help nurture empathy in children? **Shadow Lake Elementary** is looking for parents with infants who will be between 2-4 months old in October to volunteer about once per month during the school year.



What is Roots of Empathy?

Roots of Empathy is an evidence-based classroom program that has shown significant effect in reducing levels of aggression among school children while raising social/emotional competence and increasing empathy. The program has been widely evaluated across three continents for two decades and is proven to result in improved empathy, increased emotional understanding, decreased aggression and bullying and improved pro-social behavior among participating students. Research also demonstrates that these improvements are sustained and even strengthened over time.

The Roots of Empathy program is delivered to elementary school children who are guided to recognize and connect with the vulnerability and humanity of a baby who visits their classroom throughout the school year with their parent(s), along with a trained Roots of Empathy Instructor using a specialized curriculum.

How it works: (Learn more <u>here</u>)

Roots of Empathy consists of monthly visits to a classroom where your baby helps to inspire a generation of more caring, compassionate individuals. Each month, you will participate in a pre-visit, the actual classroom session, and a post-visit, each lasting approximately 30-40 minutes. A trained instructor will also be present at all times to facilitate the program.

- Your baby will need to be 2 4 months old at the start of the program in September/October
- Your family is matched with a classroom teacher at **Shadow Lake Elementary**
- You are paired with a volunteer Roots of Empathy Instructor who guides the children using an age-appropriate curriculum
- The program follows the course of the school year: You and your baby visit the same classroom of children 9 times over the school year (for 30-40 minutes, about every 3-4 weeks).

<u>Here</u> is a brief introductory video that explains how Roots of Empathy works and why a baby is such a powerful teacher of empathy. Handout information <u>here</u>. Roots of Empathy was also featured on NBC's Today – you can <u>view that segment here</u>.

REMINDER: ANNUAL VISION & HEARING HEALTH SCREENINGS – NOVEMBER 7 & 8

Young students may not complain about their vision and/ or hearing issues, as they may not know that what they are experiencing is abnormal. To ensure that students are seeing/ hearing within normal parameters, we perform hearing and vision screenings annually.

These screenings are completed in accordance with state regulations. As per this guidance, we will be screening Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 5th Grade. We will be holding these screenings on November 7 & 8, 2023.

Vision screening is not a substitute for a full eye and vision exam. Your child is not required to undergo the vision exam if they are already followed by an Optometrist or Ophthalmologist. We also will not screen children under the care of an Audiologist.

These screenings are meant to benefit your child – but if you wish for your child not to be screened, please email me at: SLNurse@TahomaSD.US. Please write your child's name, together with grade and teacher in the email, explaining that you wish them to opt out of the screenings.

You will only hear about your child's results if we believe that further follow up is required by an Optometrist, Ophthalmologist or Audiologist.


