Tiger Families and Community,

School Attendance is very important no matter the age or grade. Research and the state want students to be in class a minimum of 90% of the school year. We know that children get sick and want them to stay home when they are not well. With 180 days in the school year, which means that students can be absent 18 days of the school year and still meet the 90% threshold. Students that attend school for 90% or more of the school year are better adjusted socially and emotionally and perform better academically. You may have noticed your Tiger coming home with an Attendance award in November and December. We will continue to celebrate our Tigers that are attending school 90% or greater for the year. We have been doing great with attendance so far this year. We gave out 489 awards in December! Way to go Tigers!

We have two updates for you school-wide:


Shadow Lake, for years, has been a Title 1 school. This means that we meet a threshold percentage of students on free/reduced lunch, and we receive federal funds to support those students with their academics. In the past, you would have seen these supports support students with RAP services. This year, our free/reduced lunch status is at 36% and we were able to apply for and were granted whole school Title 1 status. This is wonderful news! We can use the federal monies for ALL students at Shadow Lake. We are using the funds this year to provide: professional development for all teachers, sub release time for teachers to work and learn with our Instructional Coach, Mrs. Gordulan, and district content specialists, provide manipulatives in both reading and math, and provide more books for our growing readers.

As you know, students in grades 3-5, take the state assessment called the SBA. The state evaluates all schools based on this data. The Washington School Improvement Framework (WSIF) looks at how schools are performing in different subgroups of students. We fell below the threshold of achievement in 2 categories in the 2022-2023 school year, and have for several years prior, in the subgroups of multilingual learners and students with disabilities. This means that Shadow Lake must be on a plan of improvement. With our partners from Office of

Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) and district leadership we have created goals in both reading and math. We have been granted additional funds from the state to support our plan of improvement. We are using these funds to partner with our local educational service district (PSESD) to plan and put on professional development for staff in the areas of math, inclusion, and language acquisition.

We are committed to improving our academic data and teaching practices to ensure that ALL Tigers are successful at school and grow as they need to!

SCHOOL COUNSELOR NEWS

Do you know someone who will be having a baby between July or August of this year? Would they like to volunteer with their baby to help nurture empathy in children? **Shadow Lake Elementary** is looking for parents with infants who will be between 2-4 months old in October 2024 to volunteer about once per month during the school year.



What is Roots of Empathy?

Roots of Empathy is an evidence-based classroom program that has shown significant effect in reducing levels of aggression among school children while raising social/emotional competence and increasing empathy. The program has been widely evaluated across three continents for two decades and is proven to result in improved empathy, increased emotional understanding, decreased aggression and bullying and improved pro-social behavior among participating students. Research also demonstrates that these improvements are sustained and even strengthened over time.

The Roots of Empathy program is delivered to elementary school children who are guided to recognize and connect with the vulnerability and humanity of a baby who visits their classroom throughout the school year with their parent(s), along with a trained Roots of Empathy Instructor using a specialized curriculum.

How it works:

Roots of Empathy consists of monthly visits to a classroom where your baby helps to inspire a generation of more caring, compassionate individuals. Each month, you will participate in a previsit, the actual classroom session, and a post-visit, each lasting approximately 30-40 minutes. A trained instructor will also be present at all times to facilitate the program.

- Your baby will need to be 2 4 months old at the start of the program in September/October
- Your family is matched with a classroom teacher at Shadow Lake Elementary
- You are paired with a volunteer Roots of Empathy Instructor who guides the children using an age-appropriate curriculum
- The program follows the course of the school year: You and your baby visit the same classroom of children 9 times over the school year (for 30-40 minutes, about every 3-4 weeks).

<u>Here</u> is a brief introductory video that explains how Roots of Empathy works and why a baby is such a powerful teacher of empathy. Roots of Empathy was also featured on NBC's Today – you can <u>view that segment here</u>.




